Department of Public Works 315-782-8081

- DPW does not pick up green waste or garbage put out to the curb
- If you have an issue with the water or sewer system or need to know what the homeowner is responsible for call 315-783-3499 or 315-783-6096 first.
- The farthest curb stop from the main is considered the owner's property and from that point on the property owner is responsible for maintenance and repair.
- Do not place any object over the sewer pot (green manhole cover) in your yard.
- Sump pumps are **NOT** to be pumped into the sewer system. This creates higher costs for the treatment of the sewer.

Treasurer/Deputy Clerk 315-782-2143

- Separate water/sewer and tax payments into two checks please.
- Call the office for past due water/sewer or tax payment for the correct amount due.
- Partial payments are not allowed and the invoice/taxes are not considered paid until full payment is received.
- You have the option to pay water/sewer invoices or property taxes online at <https://www.glenparkny.com> for an additional fee. 3% for credit cards and \$1.50 for echecks. You will receive an email confirmation receipt.

- Village only collects for Village property taxes. For Town/County or school property taxes, pay at respective jurisdiction.

- Handicap parking permits are issued for only Village residents after the completion of the application by a doctor

Police 911 or non-emergency 315-786-2601

- For Police, Fire or Ambulance **emergency** call 911
- Due to being a part-time police dept. if you have a complaint or a problem that is a non-emergency, please call Jefferson County dispatch non-emergency # at 315-786-2601. If Officer Kennedy is working, she will be dispatched; otherwise, a Sheriff Deputy or State Police Officer will respond.

Zoning 315-286-3775

- Before you dig underground call UDIG at 1-800-962-7962.
- Zoning permits can be picked up at the Village office.
- Permits are needed for, but not limited to: fences (no fee), sheds, pools, new construction, additions to buildings, and enclosure of porches.
- Permits must be approved by DPW for water/sewer, Zoning Enforcement Officer and Village Board of Trustees.
- If permit is denied, home owner can appeal to the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). The fee is \$175.00 plus public hearing publication costs. ZBA meets on an as needed basis.
- Jefferson County Building Code office, 175 Arsenal St, Watertown enforces building codes. You can get a building permit at the Village office or Jefferson County. For more information call Jefferson County at 315-785-5130.

General Information

- Dog leash law is enforced. Dog licenses are issued by the Town you live in.
 - Town of Brownville – 16431 Star School House Rd, Dexter, NY 13634. 315-639-6266
 - Town of Pamela – 25859 State Rt, 37, Watertown, NY 13601 315-785-9793
- Peddlers Permit are required for door-to- door sales. Permits can be obtained from the Village office or Clerk’s resident. The fee is \$25.00/person/year and is a three-day waiting period.
- Handicap parking permits are issued by Clerk Hoard, 116 E. Main St, Brownville after completion of the application by your doctor. Permanent parking permits are good for five years and temporary expire per application.
- Garbage pickup is contracted with Pick N Go, 800 Starbuck Ave, Watertown, NY 315-783-4122 and is picked up on Tuesdays. Spring and Fall clean-up days are on a Saturday to be determined each year.

- Recyclables can be mixed together or comingled. No cellophane bags or Styrofoam.
- Place garbage and recyclables in containers out to the curb by 6:00 AM. **Not** the night before so it does not attract animals or the wind doesn’t blow around neighborhood.
- Garbage limit to six 33- gallon clear bags not to weigh more than 40 lbs. per week.
- Garbage pickup does **NOT** include the following at any time including clean-up day, but is not limited to:
 - Metal
 - Mattresses/box springs (recyclable)
 - Electronics, anything with a plug
 - Tires
 - Hazardous materials
- Free household Hazardous Waste Collection Day.
 - Jefferson County DPW 21897 County Rt. 190, Watertown. For more information call 315-661-3234
 - A change - latex and oil paint will not be accepted.
 - NY has a new FREE program that helps recycle latex & oil-based paints. You can take to certain participating paint stores. For more information www.paintcare.org
- Items not allowed for pickup can be taken to the Jefferson County Transfer site, 27138 NYS Rt. 12, Watertown. Items are subject to fees. For hours, fees and other information call 315-786-6900.
- Green waste (grass, tree branches) can be taken to the Town of Brownville transfer site, 18554 Game Farm Rd, Brownville.
 - Wednesday 2:00 to 7:00
 - Saturday 8:00 to 3:00
 - Green waste permits are free and can be picked up at the Village office or Clerk’s home.
