March 18 – Village Elections NOW SCHEDULED BY GOVERNOR CUOMO FOR SEPTEMBER 15, 2020 In March, 2020, Governor Cuomo issued **CONTINUING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 202.4** This Executive Order stated:

“ANY VILLAGE ELECTION TO BE HELD MARCH 17, 2020 SHALL BE POSTPONED AND ANY ELECTED OFFICIAL HOLDING SUCH POSITION SHALL REMAIN IN OFFICE UNTIL SUCH TIME AS A NEW ELECTION IS HELD.”

Our Village Election was originally scheduled for Wednesday, March 18, 2020 and due to Corona Virus postponed by Governor Cuomo. On May 1, 2020, Governor Cuomo scheduled the Village Election by EXECUTIVE ORDER 202.26 for SEPTEMBER 15th. A notice will be placed on Village Office Entrance Door and six other prominent places in the Village – namely intersections at: Main/Woodlawn Ave., Main St/Huron St. Main/Superior St.; Main/Church St., Church/Park St., Church/Glen St. and Glen Park Fire Building, 630 Main St. Time and place for the

election will remain Noon to 9 p.m. at Glen Park Fire Building, 630 Main Street. Glen Park.

Ballots, which were already printed, may be used at the September 15, 2020 date, despite displaying the original date of the election.

SAT. JUNE 13TH CURBSIDE CLEAN UP DAY RULES

FOUR YARD LIMIT (approx. 6' X 6' X 3') PER HOUSEHOLD. Items accepted are: EMPTY paint cans and 5 gallon pails with tops removed, small furniture such as chairs, mattresses, box springs, household refuse, small amounts of construction debris, lumber must be less than 2 foot sections and bundled, and carpeting.

Items which are not acceptable are: tires, sealed containers, paint and chemicals, batteries, dirt, stone, metal, liquids, green waste (grass clippings, leaves, brush, tree limbs); large amounts of construction debris and any items to be recycled.

CARDBOARD BOXES USED FOR PUTTING ITEMS CURBSIDE FOR CLEAN UP DAY WILL BE LEFT BY CONTRACTOR AND PICKED UP BY CONTRACTOR THE FOLLOWING REGULAR PICK UP DAY.

Please do not place curbside any large items, such as furniture, appliances, until Clean Up Day. Next Clean Up Day is scheduled in the Fall. Watch for specific date and rules in the September issue of The Glen Park Newsletter.

REFUSE: The Village of Glen Park just renewed the refuse contract with Pick N Go, 800 Starbuck Avenue, Watertown, NY, 13601 Phone 315-783-4122. We would like to remind you at this time of the present rules for regular trash and recycle pickup. On TUESDAY pickup day, please place refuse containers in your driveway entrance by **6:00 am. Also, please separate normal refuse from those items to be recycled. The refuse limit per pick up day is **SIX 33 GAL. CLEAR BAGS NOT TO WEIGH MORE THAN 40 LB. PER BAG.****

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RECYCLABLES – CANNOT BE MIXED WITH REFUSE. All recyclables must be rinsed and cleaned.

Pick N Go asked us to inform you that cellophane bags and styrofoam are not recyclables. Please place with refuse/garbage into clear refuse bags.

a) All glass, tin, plastic and paper can be placed together in one bin.

b) Cardboard must be broken down, flattened, and tied in sizes no larger than 3 feet X 3 feet. Anything larger than 3 feet X 3 feet will not be picked up.

HANDICAPPED PARKING PERMITS are issued by Village Clerk Connie Hoard, after completion of the application by your doctor. The Permanent Parking Permits are good for five years after the date they are issued.

TOWN OF BROWNVILLE TRANSFER SITE Game Farm Road, Brownville, WEDNESDAYS, 2 PM TO 7 PM AND SATURDAYS 8 AM TO 3 PM

Town of Brownville Transfer Site accepts, for recycling, electronic equipment such as TV sets, computers and misc. electronic accessories, and **ONLY** re-chargeable batteries. They are to be placed in boxes in the separate building on the transfer site. **THE SERVICE IS FREE**

PERMITS FOR GREEN WASTE (GRASS CLIPPINGS, LIMBS AND BRUSH) AS WELL AS ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, ARE AVAILABLE ANYTIME FROM VILLAGE CLERK CONNIE HOARD (782-4508) OR THE VILLAGE OFFICE.

There is a dog leash law in the Village of Glen Park and the law is enforced. DOG LICENSES are issued by Town Clerk June McCartin, Star School House Road.

SOLICITING OR PEDDLING -No one should be soliciting within the Village of Glen Park without a Peddling Permit on their person. Please send them to the Village Office at 642 Main Street during Office Hours or call the Village Clerk anytime at (315-782-4508) to apply for a Peddling Permit. Cost of license is \$25.00 per person, per calendar year. Before issuance of the Peddling Permit, there is a 3 day waiting period after Village of Glen Park receives completed Peddling Permit application and fee.

ZONING PERMITS – SWIMMING POOLS (12 INCHES AND HIGHER) ARE CONSIDERED STRUCTURES. A ZONING PERMIT IS REQUIRED BEFORE ANY STRUCTURE OR POOL MAY BE CONSTRUCTED. FEE \$10.00 Please check with Jefferson County Code Office (315-785-5130) for obtaining any necessary permits from them.

INSTALLATION OF A FENCE REQUIRES A ZONING PERMIT APPLICATION, DPW APPROVAL, BUT NO FEE. PLEASE CHECK WITH JEFFERSON COUNTY CODE OFFICE (315-785-5130) FOR FURTHER INFORMATION ON FENCES.

If you notice any new construction of additions to buildings or sheds, please notify any Village Board member at their phone number so that the proper zoning permit applications can be completed.

Zoning Permit Applications can be picked up from the Village Office. To facilitate any new construction, including accessory buildings such as sheds, please allow sufficient time after submitting all required zoning permit applications and fees to the Village Office so that the Board of Trustees may coordinate your construction with the side and rear setback regulations for your zoning district and village sewer/and water easements in order to issue the needed zoning permit

Since Jefferson County enforces the NYS Fire & Building Code for the Village of Glen Park, anyone granted a zoning permit by the Village of Glen Park should also contact Jefferson County Building Code Office (315-785-5130) to ascertain if any additional building permit is required from Jefferson County for pool fences and any other structures.

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REMINDER TO ALL WATER/SEWER USERS: The farthest curb stop from the main will be considered the owner’s property and from that point, the owner shall be responsible for maintenance and repair. If water meter is damaged due to neglect, it will be the owner’s responsibility for the cost of repair and/or replacement by the Village of Glen Park. Please do not put anything into the sewer system which is not biodegradable. We have been continuing to experience some problems with the sewer system. Your cooperation will avoid the unnecessary expense of repairs to the system. Please do not place any items over the sewer pot or meter pit, so that the Village DPW may access the system at any time for maintenance.

PUMP USE INTO VILLAGE SEWER SYSTEM
***** PLEASE NOTE *** SUMP PUMPS**
SHOULD NOT be used to pump liquid from your residence into the Village sewer system. When this is done, it creates a huge amount of sewage and thereby increases the cost of sewer to all residents. “The owner of the property from which the inflow originated shall be billed for the inflow at the rate per gallon (based upon the Superintendent’s estimated number of gallons of inflow) times 2 times the average charge per gallon charged by the Village of Brownville to the Village of Glen Park under their Sewer Service Agreement.”

AT THE PRESENT TIME, OUR DPW DEPT IS ON DUTY 4-TEN HOUR DAYS AND ARE UNAVAILABLE, EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCIES, ON FRIDAYS UNTIL OCTOBER.

DUE DATES AND PENALTIES FOR PROPERTY AND WATER/SEWER UTILITIES TAXES- To facilitate the posting of payments this quarter, Village Treasurer would appreciate your cooperation in sending **TWO CHECKS:**

#1 -Water/Sewer Utilities July 1

“With respect to other types of fees or late payments...e.g. water, sewer, garbage) local governments **DO HAVE THE ABILITY TO EXTEND OR MODIFY LATE PENALTIES AND PAYMENTS DATES BY PROMULGATING AN EMERGENCY**

ORDER THAT SUSPENDS THE RELEVANT LOCAL LAW. Such action may only be taken after a municipality declares a local state of emergency.”

NEW DANC CHARGE ON MINIMUM WATER/SEWER BILL. There is a decrease in quarterly DANC fee from \$34.00 to \$33.32.

and #2 -Village Taxes . The last day to make payment to Village Treasurer of property taxes, with penalties, before real estate taxes are re-levied to Jefferson County, will be October 30**.

****See explanation for possible change by executive order by Governor.** Local governments **DO NOT** have unilateral authority to extend the interest free period with respect to the payment of property taxes. This may only be done pursuant to subdivision 2 of section 925-a of the Real Property Tax Law which provides that “during a state disaster emergency, the Governor may by executive order issued upon the request of the chief executive officer of a county, city, town, village or school district in the affected area extend by up to twenty-one days the final date for pay.” **TO DATE, THE GOVERNOR HAS TAKEN NO SUCH ACTION.**
